The Woodchopping Competition at the Perth Royal Show is the biggest and most prestigious in WA attracting competitors from all over Australia and New Zealand. The modern Perth Royal Show competition was launched in 1929 and grew from a two-day event to the major drawcard it is now. Woodchopping in Western Australia dates back to 1892 when the first competition was staged in Albany.

It has its origin as a sport in the days when the timber industry was thriving and much of our infrastructure, including railway sleepers, was made by hand using axes. Those working in the industry had competitions amongst themselves which became popular with onlookers, and soon woodchopping became a spectacular sport.

Terms and Conditions

General Regulations

The General Show Regulations apply to all competitions of the Show. These Conditions apply to the Woodchopping Competition only. If there is an inconsistency between the General Show Regulations and these Conditions for the Woodchopping competition, these Conditions prevail.

Upon acceptance of an entry, the Exhibitor is irrevocably contracted to be bound by the General Show Regulations and these Conditions.

A copy of the Society's General Show Regulations may be obtained on application or downloaded from the website <http://perthroyalshow.com.au/general-regulations>.

An Exhibitor who breaches any General Show Regulation or Woodchopping Conditions may be disqualified, or suspended for any period, fined or otherwise penalised.

The Society may recognise and act upon any penalty imposed by any other similar society, organisation or body in Australia on any person or exhibit.

Liability And Indemnity

The attention of Exhibitors is drawn to General Show Regulation 17, with reference to the Society's Liability and Indemnity.

Woodchopping Conditions

To be conducted under the rules of the Australian Axemen's Association at the Claremont Showground, Claremont, from Saturday 26 September to Saturday 3 October 2026.

1. Competitors' Passes

- 1.1. One Show ticket will be emailed to each Competitor for the day/s they are competing

2. Management and Control

- 2.1. Radiata Pine will be used in all Chopping and Chainsaw Events. Hardwood will be used in all Sawing Events. Flame Tree logs will be used in Junior Events. **Logs to be cut under the Rules of the Australian Axemen's Association and the administration of the Woodchopping RASWA Committee.**
- 2.2. Competitors are advised that they are **NOT** to dig footholes in the Woodchopping Arena. This will incur a fine of \$100 and/or disqualification.

- 2.3. **Only Competitors and Officials are allowed in the ring at the time of competing.** Non-compliance with this rule will mean a fine will be issued.
- 2.4. During presentations all activities of all persons **must cease** in the Woodchopping Arena.
- 2.5. Any Competitor conducting him/herself in an unruly manner, conspiring with others to cause discontent, to deceive the officials or breaching any of these Conditions may be disqualified or dealt with as the Society deems fit.
- 2.6. Juniors are not allowed to train without parent or coach supervision.
- 2.7. If available, logs may be purchased to test axes, this must be approved by the Chief Steward.
- 2.8. Hammers must be used for nailing of logs rather than the back of the axe. An axe can only be used for the cutting of footholes and trimming of trees.
- 2.9. All competitors competing in Tree Pole Events must comply with safety regulations. All competitors are to use the cage and harness provided when setting up their logs.

3. Medication Control

- 3.1. Under the provision of the Axemen's Council of WA Rules, Competitors may be tested for the presence of prohibited substances.

4. Dress

- 4.1. All Competitors will be provided with a sponsor's singlet for the duration of the Show. All Competitors must wear their provided singlet, white trousers, and appropriate footwear as indicated by the Australian Axemen's Association.

5. Judging

- 5.1. The video takes preference over the Judges. No person or Competitor is permitted to view the video prior to lodging a protest. The protest lodgment fee is \$50.
- 5.2. Please note that all championship events will be drafted into heats on the day of the event.

6. Slabbing Rule

- 6.1. Is as the 2025 Australian Axemen's Association Rule Book. This complies with Work Safe.

7. Championship Rule

- 7.1. Competitors in championship events must also have entered at least two (2) handicap events of that type.

8. Junior Exhibitors

- 8.1. Junior Exhibitors are required to have their Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s) present at all times while in the Woodchopping Arena.

9. Catalogues

- 9.1. Printed Catalogues can only be purchased online at the time of entry for \$10.00.
- 9.2. A digital Catalogue will be available online for download during the Show.

10. Adjudicating Committee

- 10.1. The purpose of the Adjudicating Committee is to resolve all matters pertaining to the competition throughout the Show.
- 10.2. The Committee will consist of the following:
- Woodchopping Competition Supervisor
 - Woodchopping Council Lead
 - Chief Steward
 - Chief Ring Steward

11. Chainsaw Events

- 11.1. As per AAA Rule 160 - A person is not eligible to enter a chainsaw event unless the entry form is accompanied by a copy of the document that certifies the person has been formally accredited or licensed by an appropriate organisation to use a chainsaw.

Prize Money

Prize money won during the Perth Royal Show will be paid by EFT (Electronic Funds Transfer). Please complete your account details on the application for entry.

The Society aims to finalise all prize money payments by the end of November. Any prize money that remains unclaimed for more than six months will be considered forfeited by the Competitor.

Prize money as stated in the Schedule does not include GST. The prize money which the Society pays to successful Competitors ("you") depends on the information that you provide to the Society.

If you confirm that you are GST registered and provide your Australian Business Number (ABN) the Society will pay the appropriate prize money plus 10% GST. The Society will provide to you a Recipient Created Tax Invoice.

Furthermore, you acknowledge your agreement to the following:

- You are requested not to issue a tax invoice to the Society in respect of prize money received.
- It will be necessary for you to notify the Society if you cease to be registered for GST: and
- The Society will notify you if it ceases to satisfy any of the requirements of determination.

If you provide your ABN but are not registered for GST, the Society will pay the prize money as detailed in the Schedule.

You must complete the Taxation Details on the Application Entry. Failure to do so will result in the Society deducting 47% of the successful Competitor's prize money under the ATO PAYG provisions.

If you confirm that you are entering as part of a private recreational pursuit or hobby, the Society will pay the prize money as detailed in the Schedule.

Awards

The Society will not be responsible for awards not received by Exhibitors after 31 December 2026. If you have not received your award by 30 November 2026, please contact the Royal Agricultural Society of WA on (08) 6263 3100.

Promotion

No advertising or promotion on behalf of commercial business will be permitted on the Showground without the prior written consent of the Society's Chief Executive Officer.
